PUTTING IT INTO PERSPECTIVE

Agents: Flood Insurance Training Requirements

In Section 207 of the National Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2004, Congress directed the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to work with the insurance industry and state regulators to adopt minimum training requirements for insurance agents selling flood insurance. FEMA published a topical outline in the *Federal Register* dated September 1, 2005, detailing the minimum course content.

In July 2009, federal regulators issued their first joint guidance on flood insurance regulations in more than a decade. "Loans in Areas Having Special Flood Hazards; Interagency Questions and Answers Regarding Flood Insurance" was published in the *Federal Register* on July 21, 2009 in response to the many inquiries that banks and lending institutions had with regard to flood insurance regulations.
